NOTICE OF INTENDED PROSECUTION

In accordance with Section 1 of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988, I hereby give you notice that it is intended to take proceedings against the driver of vehicle registration number «vrm» for the alleged offence of «ofncword» (automatic camera device/speed detection device) travelling at «speed» mph on «ofncdate» in «ofnclocn» at «ofnctime» hours.

Speed offences - Contrary to Section 89 of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 and Schedule 2 of the Road Traffic Offenders Act 1988.

or

Contravening red traffic light – Section 36 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.

THE EVIDENCE TO SUPPORT THE ALLEGATION IS PROVIDED BY PHOTOGRAPH OR OTHER APPROVED SPEED DETECTION DEVICE.

You are recorded as the registered keeper of the above vehicle at the time of the alleged offence and you are required to provide the full name and address of the driver at the time of the alleged offence.

OR

You have been named as the driver of the vehicle at the time of the alleged offence. If this is so, you are required to provide your full name and address. If you were not the driver at the time of the alleged offence, you are required to give any information in your power which may lead to the driver's identification.

UNDER SECTION 172 OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1988, YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUPPLY THE INFORMATION REQUESTED ABOVE WITHIN 28 DAYS OF SERVICE OF THIS NOTICE. ON CONVICTION FOR FAILURE TO SUPPLY INFORMATION, THE PENALTY IS SIMILAR TO THAT FOR THE ALLEGED OFFENCE ITSELF - A FINE OF UP TO £1000 PLUS PENALTY POINTS. PLEASE PROVIDE THE INFORMATION ON THE REVERSE OF THIS NOTICE.

THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THIS NOTICE MAY BE USED BY OTHER ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES FOR THE DETECTION OF FURTHER OFFENCES.
